Meeting began at 7:01 at Monadnock Paper Mill.

Guests: Marlene Paulsen of the Greenfield Conservation Commission, Ken Paulsen and Paul Renaud of the Greenfield Planning Board, Stephanie Hurley of Peterborough.

Amy Smagula, Limnologist/Exotic Species Program Coordinator/NH DES spoke to us about how local volunteers can mitigate invasive aquatic plants and insects in the river and water bodies that connect to the river. Amy described various methods of contro, stressing how important follow up surveying is to the whole success of a project. Specific ponds in the headwaters were reviewed for their impact on the river. A key to success is making sure there is local involvement in providing long term solutions. Amy also spoke about possible ways to get grant money.

No minutes were submitted.

The treasurer submitted a report of a balance of \$535.44, no vote taken.

The committee reviewed Shoreland Application 2016-02441, Philbrick, 92 Runnels Road, Concord, a single family house to a replace camper and tenting area as primary use of property. Total impact is: 9,961 sf.; new impervious area is 1350 sq. ft.

Provided that the site work complies with all shoreland protection regulations the committee decided not to provide further comment. No vote was taken.

Time being short and no other pressing business before the committee, Janet adjourned the meeting at 8:45.
