Man Arrested for Stabbing – Charged with First Degree Assault

CONCORD –. On June 26, 2018 at approximately 10:30am Concord Police arrested an adult male in relation to a stabbing that occurred in the city on June 17, 2018. Police arrested:

Jordan Patterson, 31yrs

Concord, NH

Mr. Patterson was charged with:

First Degree Assault RSA 631:1 Class “A” Felony

Possession of Controlled Drugs RSA 318-B Class “B” Felony

On June 17, 2018 at approximately 11:23pm Concord Police responded to the parking lot area of 13 Greenwood Ave for a report of male who had been stabbed. Arriving officers located a male victim who had been stabbed in the head and face area. The victim was transported to Concord Hospital by the Concord Fire Department. The victim was treated for his injuries which fortunately we not life threatening. A subsequent investigation identified the suspect as Mr. Patterson, and an arrest warrant was issued. Mr. Patterson and the victim were acquainted.

On the morning of June 27, 2018 Concord Police received a tip that Mr. Patterson may be at the Comfort Inn (71 Hall St) and armed with a gun. Numerous officers and investigators responded the hotel. Eventually officers located Mr. Patterson hiding the bathroom of a room, occupied by several other associates. Mr. Patterson was taken into custody without incident. No firearm was located however he was in possession of narcotics. Officers returned to the room with search warrant and recovered evidence and a quantity of narcotics. That investigation is ongoing and no arrests additional have been made at this time.

“Community Committed”

Mr. Patterson was held at the Merrimack County House of Corrections. He will be arraigned on **June 27, 2018 @1pm** at the **Merrimack County Superior Court**.
