Busy Afternoon for Concord Fire Department

CONCORD, NH (October 10, 2021) – Shortly before 11:45 a.m., Concord Fire Department responded to a motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Loudon Road and Route 106 to find a car on its side with one occupant trapped inside. Companies stabilized the vehicle and were able to assist the uninjured operator out the back. Crews remained on scene to further evaluate the occupant and mitigate other hazards.

Minutes after they cleared, companies were dispatched at 12:31 p.m. to a structure fire at 54 Canton Circle. Engine 7 from the Heights Fire Station arrived first. It took slightly more than 5 minutes to arrive on scene as they were still returning from the motor vehicle accident and were not at their station. Engine 7 arrived to find light smoke coming from a second-story window of an attached townhouse unit.

Upon entry into first floor of the unit, companies found a moderate smoke condition that extended from floor to ceiling. A working fire assignment was transmitted. Companies quickly located and extinguished a small kitchen fire. The Red Cross was contacted to assist five displaced residents.

Concord Fire Marshal Paul Sirois responded to the scene and determined the cause of the fire to be accidental secondary to a pot left unattended on the stovetop.

While Concord Fire Department companies were working at the fire, two mutual aid companies, Hopkinton Ambulance 1 and Hooksett Engine 5, assisted with a minor motor vehicle accident at Centre Street and North State Street at 1:04 p.m. No occupants from this accident were transported to the hospital.
