CONCORD, NH – On July 29, 2022 at approximately 10:56 p.m., Concord Police responded to the area of Summer Street in Concord for the report of a disturbance involving a male party armed with a handgun. It was reported that the male party was holding a female against her will. The male was later identified as:

Vincent Perry (DOB: 01/01/2000) Concord, NH

Continued investigation determined that Perry threatened a female with a firearm before fleeing on foot. Concord Police Officers located Perry, who matched the suspect description provided by the victim, and engaged in a brief foot pursuit. The suspect was not apprehended at that time and was last seen on foot in the vicinity of High Street, Penacook. New Hampshire State Police assisted with efforts to locate Perry, utilizing a K-9 and the New Hampshire State Police Aviation Unit.

Perry was later located by Concord Police officers on July 30, 2022 at approximately 3:28 a.m. concealing himself in vegetation at the rear of a residence on Community Drive, Penacook. Perry was taken into custody on the following Charges:

Criminal Threatening Against Person; Deadly Weapon (Felony B)
DV; Criminal Threatening Against Person; Deadly Weapon (Felony B)
DV; Simple Assault; Physical Contact (Misdemeanor A)
Simple Assault; Physical Contact or Bodily Injury (Misdemeanor A)
Reckless Conduct; Deadly Weapon (Felony B)
Resist Arrest/Detention (Misdemeanor A)
POSSESSION 3/4 OZ OR LESS OF MARIJUANA NH RSA 318-B:2-c (Violation)

There is no concern for the safety of the public at this time. Perry will be arraigned on August 1, 2022 at 1 p.m. in the Merrimack County Superior Court.
