Pleasant St. Firearm Discharge

CONCORD, NH – On January 20, 2023 at approximately 1:45 a.m. the Concord Police Department was dispatched to the area of 15 Pleasant St. in Concord to investigate a Shots Fired call for service. A witness indicated that he observed two subjects standing in the area and that one of the subjects had a handgun. The witness indicated that as he was driving out of the area, he heard a gunshot.

The Concord Police Department has received no reports of injury related to this incident. The individuals involved have been identified and interviewed. This incident is currently being investigated. It has been determined that there is no danger to the public at this time.
