Original Release – July 23, 2023:

On July 22, 2023 at approximately 2:30 p.m., Concord Police responded to 76 Basin Street for a shooting. When officers arrived, they found a 33-year-old male suffering from a gunshot wound. The male was taken to a local hospital to be treated for non-life-threatening injuries. Police are actively investigating the circumstances of the shooting. The individuals involved in the incident have been identified. It has been determined that there is no danger to the public at this time.

Update:

On August 2, 2023 the Concord Police Department arrested:

Shane Vannest, 33 years old
Concord, NH

After conducting numerous interviews and collecting both physical and digital forensic evidence, probable cause was established to charge Vannest related to the July 22, 2023 shooting at 76 Basin Street. On August 2, 2023 Vannest turned himself into Concord Police and is being charged with:

Reckless Conduct - Deadly Weapon (Felony)
Felon in Possession of a Dangerous Weapon (Pistol) (Felony)
Felon in Possession of a Dangerous Weapon (Metallic Knuckles) (Felony)
Possession of a Controlled Drug with Intent to Distribute (Marijuana) (Felony)
Possession of a Controlled Drug (Marijuana) (Felony)
Possession of a Controlled Drug with Intent to Distribute (Methamphetamine) (Felony)
Possession of a Controlled Drug (Methamphetamine) (Felony)
Possession of a Controlled Drug (Suboxone) (Felony)
Default or Breach of Bail Conditions (Misdemeanor)
Changing Marks (RSA 159:13) (Misdemeanor A)

Vannest was processed at the Concord Police Department. Vannest requested the services of a bail commissioner and was held on preventative detention. Vannest appeared in the Merrimack County Superior Court on August 3, 2023 for arraignment.
