

Melted Crayon Art



You will need:

- A canvas (whichever size you prefer)
- Crayons
- A hot glue gun
- A hair dryer
- Tarp or newspapers (to cover the splatter)
- A picture to put on the canvas (if desired)

Step 1:

Arrange the crayons in the order you would like on top of the canvas. Space them as well. Hot glue the crayons. Let dry.

Step 2:

Glue your picture onto the canvas. Cover it with another paper if you do not want it to get melted crayon it.

Step 3:

Use your hairdryer to melt the crayons. Keep it about an inch away and point the dryer downwards so that the wax will melt.

Crayon Pendants



You will need:

- Crayons
- A cheese grater with large holes
- Craft pendants with clear glass domes (we used [these](#))
- Diamond glaze (clear glue will also work)

Step 1: Grate the crayons. Use mostly lighter colors

Step 2: Gently put the crayon in the pendant. Do not smush!

Step 3: Place the pendant on a tray (cover the tray with aluminum foil)

Step 4: Place it in a toaster oven (or regular oven) at 200 degrees Fahrenheit for about 5-10 minutes. Let cool.

Step 5: Put a drop of glaze in the middle of the pendant and attach the glass dome. Let dry.

Step: Use as necklace or key chain.
