- **Market Basket in Penacook**

The Exit 17/Whitney Road shops, including the Market Basket supermarket scheduled to open next year, and the NH Liquor Store, are being built. This has been a dream of folks in Penacook for decades, and I'm very glad to have been able to help make it come true. And the road improvements at the intersection of Whitney Rd. and Route 4 will make the area safer and easier to travel.

- **More growth and tax base expansion**

Beyond the added jobs, the Whitney Road development is estimated to add \$40,000,000 in city assessment, potentially providing \$1 million in tax revenue, the equivalent of about 10% of the total Penacook tax base. This project can lead to further development with the extension of Whitney Rd. to the Concord Monitor property.

- **More housing options**

Census data shows Penacook has added the most population of any community in the city. Wards 1, 2, and 3 have all increased in population, while other areas of the city have declined in numbers of residents. Housing needs to keep pace.

- **\$20,000,000 worth of projects in Penacook**

Since I've been serving as Ward 1 Councilor, the city has invested \$20,000,000 toward municipal and special projects in Penacook, including the repaving of many streets. We can expect reclamation, drainage and paving work to occur next year on twenty Penacook streets.
