The golden key enclosed in this time capsule was a gift from the Mayor of the City of Portsmouth to one George Lovejoy of Concord on Saturday, August 7, 1965 on the occasion of the Concord Bicentennial Caravan visit to Strawberry Bank in the City of Portsmouth.

The Mayor, it is said, presented the Key to Mr. Lovejoy for the express purpose of "getting him out of town in the fastest and most expedient manner".
