Discuss the final result of the new pick-up configuration that resulted from the referral from Councilor Kretovic regarding constituent concerns about PM parent pick-up of students and the on-street parking along Sewalls Falls Road near Beaver Meadow School that interferes with Sewalls Falls Road through-travel.
- c. Discuss some options to address the concern about an increase in the traffic accidents at the intersection of Green, South, and Pleasant Streets.
- d. Follow-up discussion on the possible options to address the confusing traffic light/lane configuration at the North Main Street/I-393 intersection in response to Paul Halvorsen's concerns.
- e. Discuss recent traffic/speed counts on Little Pond around curve just west of Pond Place Lane and near 34 Little Pond Rd to address the resident concerns.
