Another Busy Afternoon for Concord Fire Department

CONCORD, NH (April 27, 2021) – A flurry of activity on Tuesday afternoon had all Concord Fire Department units committed on incidents. Starting at 3:33 p.m., Engine 7 responded to a bark mulch fire on Regional Drive. At 3:50 p.m., all three CFD ambulances along with Engine 4, Tower 1, and the shift commander, responded to the area of 329 Clinton Street for a multi-vehicle accident. While companies were operating at the motor vehicle accident, Engine 7 was dispatched to a roadside fire on Interstate 93 at 4:19 p.m. At 4:31 p.m. a building fire was reported at a Cross Street residence. With most Concord units committed on incidents, mutual aid from Boscawen and Bow were also dispatched to the Cross Street fire. Concord Engine 5 arrived at Cross Street and located and extinguished a small fire in an attached storage area. As companies were preparing to clear Cross Street, companies were notified of an area of 29 Bog Road, Building 2, which had reignited. Companies arrived on scene and discovered an area of blown-in insulation in a confined space had reignited. The fire was quickly extinguished. Both fires remain under investigation. The Department would like to remind the community that even with rain in the coming forecast, conditions remain dry and fire danger will likely remain high.
