South Street Building Fire

CONCORD, NH (September 23, 2021) – At 6:10 p.m. this evening, Concord Fire Department was dispatched to 29 South Street for a report of a fire in the building.

Engine 4 from the Broadway Fire Station arrived on scene within 3 minutes. Upon arrival they encountered heavy smoke coming from a two and a half story wood frame residential dwelling with three apartments. Concord companies initiated an interior fire attack and conducted search operations throughout the building. A second alarm was transmitted bringing additional off duty Concord Fire personnel and mutual aid from Boscawen, Chichester, Hooksett, Hopkinton, Loudon, and Pembroke to the scene. Two occupants were transported to the hospital in serious condition by Concord Fire Department ambulance.

Concord Fire Chief Sean Brown stated, “The buildings in this neighborhood are very close to each other. The aggressive firefighting actions taken by the first arriving Concord companies prevented any of the adjacent structures from being threatened by fire extension.”

The fire was placed under control at 8:10 p.m. A total of eight occupants were displaced by the fire. Station coverage was provided by Epsom, Franklin, Hopkinton, Manchester, and Penacook Ambulance. The fire remains under investigation by the Concord Fire Department and the Concord Police Department.
