



Facilities Naming Committee
Meeting Minutes
May 8, 2007
City Council Chambers, 37 Green Street
4:00 p.m.

Attendance: Councilor Bennett, Chair, Councilors Coen, Rowe and Stetson were present.
Guests: Anita Hickey and Carolyn Tracy, Recreation Director.

The meeting was called to order at 4:20 p.m. by Chair Bennett.

Broken Ground Area

Chair Bennett informed the Facilities Naming Committee that he had conversed with Superintendent Chris Rath in regards to naming a parcel of land located within the Broken Ground area on Batchelder Mill Road, map/lot/block 118-1-7, in honor of former Mayor C. David Coeyman. He explained that Superintendent Rath indicated that she supported the proposed plan to naming the parcel of land in memory of the former Mayor C. David Coeyman.

Councilor Coen inquired whether the Coeyman family had been contacted and what they thought of the proposal. Chair Bennett informed the committee that it was his understanding that Robert Washburn had spoken with Mrs. Coeyman and the family was pleased with the proposal.

Councilor Rowe moved to name a parcel of land located on Batchelder Mill Road, map/lot/block 118-1-7, "Coeyman Park." The motion was duly seconded by Councilor Stetson and passed with no dissenting votes.

Terrill Park – Dog Park

Recreation Director Carolyn Tracy provided a brief overview of the policy for naming city facilities, as adopted July 14, 1997.

Mrs. Anita Hickey noted that they did not want to change the park name, only name the two sections within the dog park at Terrill Park in memory of Jack Hickey and Sandy Sanel.

Chair Bennett and Councilor Coen noted their support of the proposal.

Councilor Stetson inquired as to whether the Friends of the Dog Park would be responsible for the signage costs.

Mrs. Hickey responded that the signage costs will be paid for with the funds raised by the Friends of the Dog Park.

Councilor Rowe moved to name the two sections of the dog park in honor of Jack Hickey and Sandy Sanel. The motion was duly seconded by Councilor Coen and passed with no dissenting votes.

There being no further business, Councilor Rowe moved to adjourn the meeting at 5:05 p.m. The motion was duly seconded and passed with no dissenting votes.
