### **Aquatics Update from Concord Parks & Recreation**

CONCORD, NH (May 29, 2024) – The Concord Parks & Recreation Department is happy to announce that the splash pad at White Park opens on Saturday, June 1. It will be open on weekends only (for now) from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on the following dates: June 1, 2, 8, 9, 15 and 16.

Non-resident pool/splash passes go on sale beginning Thursday, May 30 at 9 a.m. at the City-Wide Community Center, 14 Canterbury Road, Concord. Season passes are \$125 per family and 48-hour access passes are \$20 per family. Concord/Penacook residents can access the splash pad and pools by showing a valid ID upon entry.

Swim lesson registrations begin on Tuesday, June 4 at 9 a.m. at the City-Wide Community Center. Online registration opens on June 5 at 10 a.m.

The Concord Parks and Recreation Department is pleased to once again announce a generous sponsorship from Concord Housing + Redevelopment Authority that allows Concord and Penacook children to take part in free swim lessons this summer. With this sponsorship, each Concord/Penacook child will be able to receive a two-week session of swim lessons (eight classes) for free (as space allows). To take advantage of the free swim lessons, residents must register in person with the Concord Parks & Recreation Department at the City-Wide Community Center, 14 Canterbury Road, Concord. Proof of residency is required (driver's license, utility bill etc.). In-person registrations for free swim lessons begins on Tuesday, June 4 at 9 a.m.
