



Pool Opening News

CONCORD, NH (June 15, 2022) – The Concord Parks and Recreation Department will open four pools for the season at 12:30 p.m. on Sunday, June 19: Rollins, Keach, Merrill and Rolfe Pools. The Department hopes to open other pools as additional staff are hired and trained.

Unfortunately, over the past several weeks, the Parks and Recreation Department has had sixteen staff either resign due to other commitments (jobs, sports, personal, etc.) or who were unable to pass the certification class. This significant reduction in staffing prevents the Department from opening other pools at this time. The four pools opening on Sunday were chosen based on the locations with the highest participation levels.

The weekly hours of the four pools opening on Sunday are:

Monday – Friday: 12:30 – 4:30 p.m. and 6 – 7:30 p.m., and Saturday/Sunday: 12:30 – 4:30 p.m.

The pools are free for Concord and Penacook residents with ID. Please bring a form of ID each time you use the pool. Non-residents can buy a season-long pool pass for \$125 or a 48-hour pass for \$20. Both passes can be purchased at the Parks and Recreation Office at the City Wide Community Center, 14 Canterbury Road.
