City of Concord Positive COVID-19 Report

Concord, NH (September 18, 2020) – On September 18, 2020, the City of Concord was notified that an employee in the Code Division tested positive for COVID-19. The employee is an inspector and has limited interaction with the public except during inspections. The employee was wearing a face mask during all inspections. NH DHHS will be contacting customers with whom the employee had close interactions during inspections.

The City of Concord is committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of its employees and citizens. Following the guidelines set forth by the CDC and the State of New Hampshire, the employee who tested positive is self-isolating. Other employees who had close contact are observing fourteen-day quarantine. The Code Division will be closed on September 20, 2020 to be professionally sanitized.
