NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Concord Planning Board will hold a public SITE WALK in accordance with provisions of the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated 91-A:2 on Wednesday, April 29, 2015, beginning at 5:30 pm, embarking from Portsmouth Street (Map/Block/Lot 113/2/9), at the access road to the City water tower, just west of the I-393 overpass.

The site walk is requested by the Planning Board and the applicant in consideration of the application by TF Moran on behalf of Until and Eversource (f.k.a. PSNH) requesting Major Site Plan approval at Portsmouth Street for the construction of a new distribution substation, which will be supplied by a proposed transmission substation within the Open Space Residential (RO) District. A Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to construct Essential Public Utilities & Appurtenances within the Open Space Residential (RO) District as well as a CUP for disturbances to wetland buffers is also requested.

All applications are on file in the Planning Division's office in City Hall and may be reviewed any time between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday.
