### **Armed Robbery: Looking to Identity Suspects**

CONCORD – On Saturday, October 21, 2017, at approximately 12:20 AM, the Concord Police responded to an Armed Robbery at the Shell Gas Station at 24 Loudon, Concord, NH.

The victim, a female store clerk, reported that two men entered the store with bandanas or shirts duct taped over their lower faces. One man approached the register and pointed a handgun at the clerk, while the second man remained at the door as an apparent lookout. The suspect with the gun told the clerk that this was a robbery and demanded that she give him the register drawer. The clerk complied with the demand. Once the drawer was handed over, the suspect demanded cigarettes. Upon receiving several packs of cigarettes, both suspects then fled the store on foot in an easterly direction towards Loudon Road. The suspects obtained an undisclosed amount of money and cigarettes. No one was injured during the incident.

Both suspects are believed to be white men in their mid-20's, approximately 5'10", with heavy builds. The suspect with the gun wore a dark hooded sweatshirt with white writing, blue pants, and white sneakers. That suspect wore the hood of his sweatshirt up and had a bandana over his lower face which was held in place with what appeared to be silver duct tape that extended completely around his head. That suspect also carried a black backpack into which he placed the money and cigarettes. His sweatshirt appeared to have the number "5" on the back along with other writing and an unknown symbol on the front.

The second suspect wore a dark shirt with light pants and gray sneakers, along with a dark-colored baseball hat. That suspect had what appeared to be a t-shirt over the lower portion of his face, which was also held in place with silver duct tape that extended completely around his head.
