Man Arrested on numerous Felonies related to Stabbing and other behaviors at city bar.

CONCORD –. On October 31, 2018 at approximately 5:40pm Concord Police arrested an adult male in relation to a stabbing that occurred at The Draft Sports Bar and Grille on October 20, 2018. Police arrested:

Kyle Anderson, 35yrs

Concord, NH

Mr. Anderson was charged with:

1st Degree Assault w/Deadly Weapon (RSA 631:1)- Class A Felony

2nd Degree Assault; Deadly Weapon & BI (RSA 631:2)- Class B Felony

Reckless Conduct - Deadly Weapon (RSA 631:3)- Class B Felony

Reckless Conduct - Deadly Weapon (RSA 631:3)- Class B Felony

Simple Assault; Physical Contact or BI (RSA 631:2-A)- Class A Misdemeanor

On October 20, 2018 at approximately 12:35am the Concord Police and Fire Departments responded to The Draft located at 67 S. Main St for a report of a stabbing. NH State Police assisted at the scene. Upon arrival first responders encountered the adult male victim who was suffering from multiple stab wounds to the upper torso. The victim who was seriously injured was transported to Concord Hospital and subsequently flown to a Boston Hospital for treatment.

A subsequent investigation identified the suspect as Mr. Anderson. Through numerous interviews of witnesses, review of security video, and evidence gathered, investigators learned that Mr. Anderson engaged in several altercations with other patrons, prior to the stabbing incident. Mr. Anderson who appeared to be under the influence, approached two other males not

known to him, and grabbed one of the males by the groin. He then displayed a knife and held it against the neck of another random male patron.

Minutes later Mr. Anderson made his way to another unsuspecting group of patrons. He also made a comment at a female and had physical contact with her. He then physically confronted a friend of the female and a fight ensued. After disengaging from the fight Anderson and the male had words and while in close proximity Anderson pulled out a knife and stabbed the male victim numerous times in the torso.

Mr. Anderson was held without bail and will be arraigned on **November 1, 2018 @1pm** at the **Merrimack County Superior Court.**

The police are asking the public for any information pertaining to this incident and Mr. Anderson. Concord Police are also still investigating and seeking information about an incident where a firearm was discharged on February 10, 2017, at the Draft Bar. Please contact Lt.
