## **Concord Firefighters Respond to Multiple Accidents**

CONCORD, NH (February 7, 2022) – On February 6 at 3:16 p.m., Concord units responded to Interstate 93 southbound, between exits 14 and 13, for a report of a multiple vehicle collision. Engine 4 arrived on scene and personnel confirmed multiple vehicles involved, with vehicles blocking all travel lanes, causing I-93 to be shut down for a short period of time. Ambulance 7 transported one unrestrained passenger, in one of the vehicles, with minor injuries to Concord Hospital. All companies cleared at 4:23 p.m.

At 9:17 p.m. on February 6, units responded to Interstate 93 southbound in the area of the exit 13 off ramp for a motor vehicle accident with a vehicle on its side. Ambulance 4 was first on scene reporting that the restrained operator was still in the vehicle uninjured but needed assistance exiting the vehicle. Tower 1 stabilized the vehicle and removed the windshield with the assistance of Engine 7. Ambulance 4 evaluated the patient who was not transported to the hospital.

Later that same night at 11:21 p.m., Engine and Ambulance 5 responded to Carter Hill for a report of a motor vehicle accident with a vehicle off the road. Upon the arrival of Station 5, the vehicle was in the woods, well involved in fire, and a tree was across the power lines. The operator was able to exit his vehicle before the fire started and was uninjured. The vehicle fire was extinguished and the driver refused transport. All units cleared the scene at 2:10 a.m.
