CONCORD, NH – On July 28, 2022 Concord Police took a report of a suspicious male who was observed peeking into windows of a residence on West Street. During the investigation it was learned that the same male was seen peeping into the same residence on multiple occasions. Investigators obtained video surveillance which captured the male suspect on the West Street property on numerous instances. Concord Police Detectives were able to identify the male suspect as:

**Joseph Lecouffe, age 56
Concord, NH**

On August 5, 2022, Lecouffe was charged with:

**Stalking- Place Individual in Fear
Violation of Privacy/Sexual Gratification**

Lecouffe was arraigned in the Concord District Court on August 8, 2022 and was held on preventative detention. He is currently being held at the Merrimack County House of Corrections.
