CONCORD, NH – On the afternoon of April 10, 2022 members of the Concord Police Department responded to the intersection of Park Street and N. Main Street in downtown Concord to investigate reports of a disturbance involving gunfire.

Further investigation revealed that the disturbance was the result of a disagreement between members and affiliates of the “Knights of Sin” motorcycle club, the “Outlaws” motorcycle club and the “Hells Angels” motorcycle club. It was determined that one gunshot was fired from a handgun during the incident. No injuries were reported by any of the involved parties.

On August 11, 2022 the Concord Police Department arrested Jeremy Ducharme, age 39, of Concord, NH. He was charged with:

Reckless Conduct – Deadly Weapon (B Felony)

Unauthorized Use of a Firearm (Violation)

Disorderly Conduct (Violation)

Ducharme was released on his own personal recognizance and is scheduled to be arraigned at Merrimack County Superior Court on September 1, 2022.
