CONCORD, NH – At around 1 a.m. on August 27, 2022 members of the Concord Police Department responded to the area of Eagle Square, located near the intersection of Capitol and N. Main Street in downtown Concord to investigate reports of a disturbance involving gunfire.

Upon arrival, officers found one adult male that had been shot. Officers administered first aid until paramedics from the Concord Fire Department arrived. The man was transported to Concord Hospital with serious injuries. His condition is unknown at this time.

Initial investigation has indicated that all involved parties were patronizing a restaurant/bar in the area prior to the shooting. The incident occurred near closing time and it is believed that there were several witnesses. The Concord Police Department is asking for anyone that witnessed this incident to please contact them and ask to speak with an investigator (603-225-8600).
