CITY OF CONCORD

AN ORDINANCE

In the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three.

Changing the number of members of the Conservation Commission from five to seven.

The City of Concord ordains as follows:

	SECTION ONE: Amend Chapter 32 of the Municipal Code of Ordinances pertaining
	to the Conservation Commission by deleting subsection (b) thereof, and inserting the
	following section in its place.
	(B) The Commission shall consist of seven (7) members, all
	citizens of Concord and all appointed by the City Manager. The City Manager shall
	appoint the chairman for a term of three years. In the event the City Manager
	appoints another member of the Commission, who has not completed his own term, to
	succeed to a new term as Chairman, the said member shall resign his own term and
	commence serving the full term as Chairman. The remaining six members of the Commis-
	sion shall serve for terms of three years with the terms being set up so that two
	members shall be appointed each year. Any member of the Commission so appointed may,
	after a public hearing, if requested, be removed for cause by the City Manager.
	A vacancy occurring otherwise than by expiration of a term shall be filled for the
	unexpired term in the same manner as an original appointment.
	SECTION TWO: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
)
