CITY OF CONCORD

In the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-eight.

AN ORDINANCE amending Title V, Administrative Code, Conservation Commission, of the Code of Ordinances.

The City of Concord ordains as follows:

Section I: Amend the Code of Ordinances, Title V, Administrative Code, Article 30-3, Boards and Commissions, Section 30-3-12, Conservation Commission, by striking subsection (b) and substituting in place thereof the following:

(b) The commission shall consist of seven (7) regular members, all citizens of Concord, and one city council representative. The city manager shall appoint seven (7) regular members of the commission who shall serve staggered terms of three years. The regular members shall annually elect one of their number as chairman. The city manager shall also appoint three (3) alternate members to the commission to act in the place of an absent or disqualified regular member. Alternate members shall serve for three-year staggered terms. The chairman shall designate one of the alternates to serve in the place of an absent or disqualified member.

Section II: Amend the Code of Ordinances, Title V, Administrative Code, Article 30-3, Boards and Commissions, Section 30-3-12, Conservation Commission, by striking subsection (f) and substituting in place thereof the following:

(f) The City Council shall appoint one of its members in January of each even year to serve as its representative on the commission. The council representative shall have the right to take part in the discussion of and vote on all matters coming before the commission.

Section III: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
