

PUBLIC SKATING & STICK PRACTICE OPERATIONS

All Participants to Follow State, CDC and City of Concord Guidelines

All Participants to self-attest that they are Free of COVID19 symptoms per screening questions at the main entrance.

ENTRANCE & EXIT

- Main Entrance to be used as Enter Only
- Exit Only Doors – NW Doors Riverside of Building

PUBLIC SKATING OPERATIONS:

1. Doors will open 15 minutes before Scheduled Session
2. All groups to enter through the Main Entrance and Exit the NW side of building
3. Masks Required when in the arena except when on the ice
4. Mask Up after Exiting the ice surface
5. Maintain Social Distancing while on and off the ice
6. Follow Signage for Entering and Exiting the Ice Surface
7. Limited Occupancy for Public Skating at this time
8. 1 Parent/Guardian allowed per on ice youth skater in building, no siblings
9. All Skaters to skate in the same direction
10. No Spitting
11. No Communal Food
12. Skate Rentals available in Pro Shop
13. Rental Skates are Disinfected After Each Use
14. A limited number of Skate Aide Walkers Available in the Pro Shop
15. Please Return Walkers to the Pro Shop for Disinfecting after use
16. When Session Ends Please Exit through the NW Doors on the Riverside

STICK PRACTICE OPERATIONS:

1. Doors will open 15 minutes before Scheduled Session
2. All groups to enter through the Main Entrance and Exit the NW side of building
3. Masks Required when in the arena except when on the ice
4. Mask Up after Exiting the ice surface
5. Sessions Limited to 20 Skaters and 2 Goalies
6. 1 Parent/Guardian allowed per on ice youth player in building, no siblings
7. Enter Ice Through Players Bench
8. No Spitting
9. No Communal Food
10. No Sharing Water Bottles
11. When Session Ends Please Exit through the NW Doors on the Riverside
