

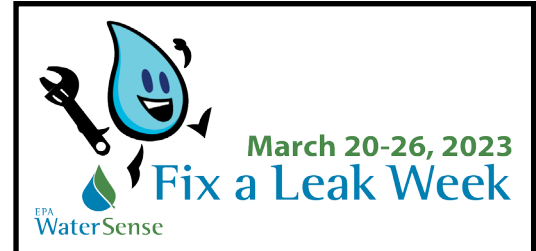
Royal Leak Detection

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES

PERFORM A "ROYAL" LEAK DETECTION & ENTER FOR A CHANCE TO WIN A NEW "THRONE" (TOILET)!

CONTEST:

Leaks can be a royal pain! A leaky faucet, toilet, showerhead, or irrigation system may seem harmless, but did you know more than 10,000 gallons of water are wasted each year from leaks in the average household? March 20-26, 2023 is National Fix a Leak Week. This annual event is hosted by EPA WaterSense to encourage household inspections for water leaks to save water, energy, and possibly even money on utility bills. Perform a household leak detection and enter our Royal Leak Detection contest to share how you have found and fixed leaks for a chance to win a new "throne" (WaterSense-labeled toilet).



HOW TO ENTER:

Enter one of two ways - or **enter both ways to double your chance to win!**

1. Submit a Contest Entry Form

2. Share How You Have Found & Fixed Leaks with Us on Social Media

WHAT IS WATERSENSE?

WaterSense is a program by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency that is a resource for saving water and a label for water-efficient products. WaterSense-labeled products are certified to use at least 20% less water, save energy, and perform as well as or better than regular models. The City of Concord has been a WaterSense Promotional Partner since March 2014 to encourage water conservation and preserve Concord's public water supply.

PRIZE:

One contest entry will be randomly selected to win one [Glacier Bay Power Flush White Elongated Toilet](#), featuring:

- WaterSense certification for high performance and water efficiency with 1.28 GPF (gallons per flush).
- 16.5" tall bowl (2-4" higher than standard) for added comfort.
- Flapper-less design means no flapper, chains, or levers to replace or leaks to fix. Fill valve is not exposed, eliminating refill noise. Slow-close seat prevents slamming.
- Extra large trapway prevents clogs with vacuum-assisted flush. Niagara Stealth Technology provides a quiet, powerful flush to fully empty the bowl and eliminate double flushing.
